Warrington Pride returns on Saturday, June 14th 2025, with a packed programme of events, activities and performances across the town centre throughout the month. From creative workshops and community talks to disco dance parties and drag performances, there's plenty happening for all ages to enjoy.

SATURDAY, JUNE 14TH 2025 - PRIDE DAY EVENTS

PARADE AND PRE-PARADE ACTIVITIES

Kick off your Pride Day with arts and crafts at the University of Chester's town centre campus. Warrington Youth Zone will be running a colourful activity session from 10.15am to 11.45am. Families and young people are welcome to create flags, banners, and badges to carry in the parade - no booking is needed.

The Tender Heart Conversation Space will also open in the University from 10am before the start of the parade (Ted Talk space, downstairs). This session is being facilitated by Story Stitchers & Culture Warrington.

QUEER COFFEE CHANGING SPACE:

Open 9.30am-5pm, with private changing facilities, lockers and a small wardrobe of donated clothing (seminar room 2, upstairs). Venue: University of Chester Campus. 18+ only.

QUEER COFFEE ZINE MAKING:

10am-5pm, create your own zine from scratch using writing, collage and crafts (lecture room B, upstairs). Venue: University of Chester Campus. 18+ only.

From 10:45am, head to Time Square, where a series of short speeches will take place before kicking off Pride in style this year with **Big Fatt Dance Party**; expect powerhouse live vocals and some interactive dance routines to get audiences dancing and singing their hearts out before the Pride march. The parade will set off at 12pm, and make its joyful, inclusive journey through the streets of Warrington before finishing at Golden Square. Expect rainbow flags, music, community groups.




